

Finger-jointed pine



Porta finger-jointed pine is a knot-free paint grade timber joined end to end utilising a micro sized finger joint and interior grade adhesive. The overall strength and length of the timber is enhanced through the glue-bonds.

Finger-jointed mouldings are a cost effective product as waste is mimised through recapturing timber off-cuts which would otherwise be disposed off.

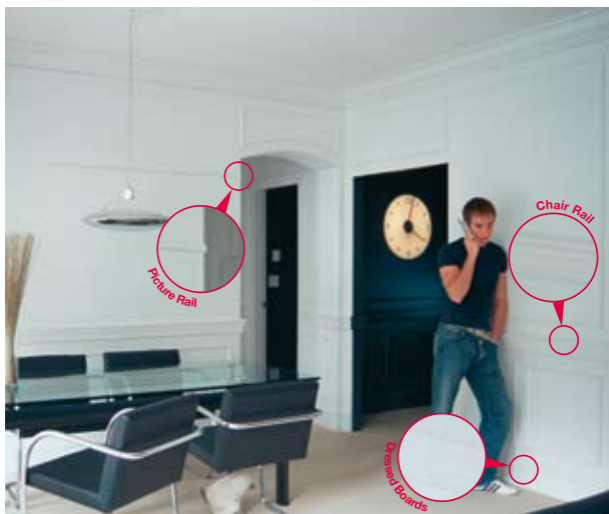

What goes where?

Picture Rail

Fixed horizontally and running high around the perimeter of a room, picture rails provide for the ready hanging of both pictures and mirrors.

Dressed Boards

Square dressed boards come in a variety of sizes and are used in modern homes as skirting boards and architraves. Boards of 90mm thickness can create a modern sleek look in any room.

Chair Rail

Chair rail serves as a decorative function encircling the perimeter of the room and/or separating different wall finish treatments. They are generally affixed horizontally along a wall at a height of 900mm to 1200mm.
