Porta treated mouldings are designed for long term performance with special preservatives that protect against termites, rot, decay and weather. They're ready to stain or paint and are ideal for a variety of external applications.

timber treatment	Porta's treated mouldings are treated using Copper fixed waterborne preservatives commonly known as Tanalised E and ACQ. <i>For further information on Timber Treatments refer to the Timber Preservers Association of Australia (TPAA) website www.tpaa.com.au.</i>
durability	protected from rot, fungal, decay and termite attack for 50+ years. H3 rating
applications	suitable for external applications such as playground products, patios, decks, garden and landscaping structures, fencing and outdoor furniture.
colour	the preservative treatment used will tint the colour of the timber a green or brown tinge. A stain can be used to get the desired finish you are after.
finishing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• can be painted or stained to match any outdoor colour scheme.• all treated timber should be protected from the weather. It's recommended to apply a clear water repellent or alternatively stain with a water repellent.• please note that when modifying the original dimension of treated mouldings, you may expose untreated heartwood. Please apply a brush on preservative on all cut-ends or planed surfaces.
nailing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• use high quality hot-dipped galvanized or stainless steel nails, screws and bolts.• direct contact of Porta treated mouldings with aluminium is not recommended.
sawing	use carbon tipped blade saw to cut treated timbers.
sizes	available in lengths of 1.2, 1.8 & 2.4m

Porta treated pine is suitable for external applications such as playground products, patio, decks, garden and landscaping structures and fencing and outdoor furniture.



Safety Information

- Always wear gloves, dust mask and goggles when working with treated timber.
- Do not burn treated timber.
- Do not bring treated timber in contact with drinking water.
- Do not use treated wood shavings or sawdust as animal litter.
- Wash exposed skin areas thoroughly after use.
- Wash clothes separately from other household clothing before re-use.
- Porta treated mouldings may be disposed of in landfills or burned in commercial or industrial incinerators or boilers in accordance with state, federal and local regulations.
