■ Appearance & Finish

- The term *Meranti* is applied to a large number of species of Shorea, which is a dominant hardwood in South East Asia.
- Due to the number of timber species in the Meranti family, there will be colour variation from pale pink to dark red and straw through to yellow.
- Meranti can be stained to enhance its consistent grain or painted to blend in with your colour scheme.

Porta Handy Tips

Pre-drill recommended to prevent splitting.

Finishing

- Can be painted, stained or polished.
- Being an open grain timber may need to be filled and/or primed if painting.
 - Apply finish to mouldings before installing.

 Due to the number of species included under Colour/Appearance the Meranti name there will be colour variations ranging from pale pink to dark red and from straw through to yellow. If you are staining you may wish to select pieces that are close in colour to optimise stain result.
