



Statement of Performance

Porta Cumaru is Class 1

Porta's Cumaru timber durability against mould attack is Class 1, in accordance with the specifications laid down in Australia Standard 5604 Natural Durability Ratings for outside, above-ground applications (Hazard Class H3 as specified in AS 5604).

Porta's Cumaru timber provides a predicted service life greater than 40 years in outside, above-ground applications.

A copy of the test report is available on request, from Porta.

Cumaru is used extensively in a range of high durability applications and has been rated as very durable.

Additionally based on international use Porta Cumaru probable in-ground durability is greater than 25 years, which would rate it as Class 1 in-ground (Hazard Class H4 as specified in AS 5604).
